
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Under the current federal and state law,
2 crematoriums constructed prior to March 20, 1972, are exempt
3 from air pollution control permit requirements, including those
4 contained in chapter 342B, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The
5 legislature finds that it is in the interest of the public
6 health to require all crematoriums operating within the State to
7 be subject to air pollution control permitting requirements.

8 SECTION 2. Chapter 342B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
10 and to read as follows:

11 "§342B- Crematoriums. (a) All crematoriums of human
12 remains operating within the State shall be subject to the
13 permit requirements of this chapter; provided that owners or
14 operators of crematoriums constructed before March 20, 1972, and
15 operating within the State without a permit shall submit permit
16 applications to the department no later than December 31, 2015.



1 (b) The department may adopt rules to impose permit
2 conditions to minimize ambient air quality impacts caused by
3 crematoriums."

4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
