# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE FINANCES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the national and  
2 global economic crisis that began in the second half of 2008 has  
3 caused significant economic problems in numerous industries in  
4 the State. Difficult economic times and declining tax revenues  
5 resulted in significant budget cuts and a reduction of state  
6 government core services.

7           The reduction in services has jeopardized the safety net of  
8 basic human services, health, and education needs for Hawaii's  
9 residents and families. While all of Hawaii's residents have  
10 been affected by the situation, gap group families and families  
11 closest to the poverty line have been severely impacted.

12           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to support  
13 programs essential to education, public health, and public  
14 welfare and begin to repair the decimated safety net.

15           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so  
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
18 respite services.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 health for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general  
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
6 supplement the healthy start program.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
8 health for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general  
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
12 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
13 Revised Statutes, to:

14 (1) Catholic Charities Hawaii for the Lanakila

15 Multi-Purpose Senior Center \$

16 (2) Moiliili Community Center for the

17 Moiliili Senior Center Program \$

18 (3) Waikiki Community Center \$

19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
20 health for the purposes of this Act.

21 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general  
22 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so



1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
2 the kupuna care program.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
4 health for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general  
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
8 the developmental disabilities medicaid waiver program.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
10 health for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general  
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
14 adult mental health services.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
16 health for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general  
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
20 the long-term adult supports and resources program.

21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
22 health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
4 substance abuse treatment and prevention services for adults and  
5 adolescents.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
7 health for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general  
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
11 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
12 Revised Statutes, to the Coalition for a Drug-Free Hawaii for  
13 substance abuse prevention services to youth and their families  
14 in the Kapolei district.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
16 health for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general  
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
20 the healthy aging partnership program.

21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
22 health for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
4 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
5 Revised Statutes, to the Waianae District Comprehensive Health  
6 and Hospital Board, Inc., to support its emergency room  
7 services.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
9 health for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 13. There is appropriated out of the general  
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
13 HIV/AIDS related services.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
15 health for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 14. There is appropriated out of the general  
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
19 health care services for individuals who are uninsured and  
20 underinsured at federally qualified health centers on the  
21 islands of Hawaii, Kauai, Maui, Lanai, Molokai, and Oahu.

1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 health for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 15. There is appropriated out of the general  
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to:

- 6 (1) Increase children's oral health services and  
7 prevention services;
- 8 (2) Increase public awareness of oral health through  
9 outreach and education programs; and
- 10 (3) Establish and implement an electronic system to track  
11 data on children's dental health.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
13 health for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 16. There is appropriated out of the general  
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
17 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
18 Revised Statutes, to Kokua Kalihi Valley (Comprehensive Family  
19 Services).

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
21 health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 17. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
4 services to pregnant women struggling with addiction.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
6 health for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 18. There is appropriated out of the general  
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
10 the baby S.A.F.E. (substance abuse free environment) program.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
12 health for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 19. There is appropriated out of the general  
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
16 fetal alcohol spectrum disorders.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
18 health for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 20. There is appropriated out of the general  
20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
22 family planning services.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 health for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 21. There is appropriated out of the general  
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
6 perinatal health programs.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
8 health for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 22. There is appropriated out of the general  
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
12 the preschool developmental screening program.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
14 health for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 23. There is appropriated out of the general  
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
18 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
19 Revised Statutes, to Planned Parenthood of Hawaii for statewide  
20 sexual health education.

21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
22 health for the purposes of this Act.





1 SECTION 24. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
4 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
5 Revised Statutes, to Child and Family Service for family centers  
6 on the island of Kauai named Nana's House and Hale Ho'omaluu.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
8 human services for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 25. There is appropriated out of the general  
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
12 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
13 Revised Statutes, to Child and Family Service for permanency  
14 support services on the island of Oahu.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
16 human services for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 26. There is appropriated out of the general  
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
20 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
21 Revised Statutes, to Child and Family Service for substance  
22 abuse counseling services on the island of Maui.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 27. There is appropriated out of the general  
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
6 comprehensive counseling and support services statewide.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
8 human services for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 28. There is appropriated out of the general  
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
12 resource family recruitment, licensing, and training under the  
13 Hui Ho'omaluu Consortium.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
15 human services for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 29. There is appropriated out of the general  
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
19 the Waianae receiving home.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
21 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 30. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
4 multi-disciplinary teams and psychological evaluations.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
6 human services for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 31. There is appropriated out of the general  
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
10 ohana conferencing.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
12 human services for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 32. There is appropriated out of the general  
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
16 the interstate compact for the placement of children.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
18 human services for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 33. There is appropriated out of the general  
20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
22 family strengthening services.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 34. There is appropriated out of the general  
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
6 parenting skills training.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
8 human services for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 35. There is appropriated out of the general  
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
12 teen pregnancy prevention.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
14 human services for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 36. There is appropriated out of the general  
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
18 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
19 Revised Statutes, to the Blueprint for Change for neighborhood  
20 place walk-in centers.

21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
22 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 37. There is appropriated out of the general  
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
 4 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
 5 Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care Association for the  
 6 Hawaii immigrant health initiative program provided at federally  
 7 qualified health centers.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
 9 human services for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 38. There is appropriated out of the general  
 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
 13 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
 14 Revised Statutes, to Susannah Wesley Community Center for  
 15 afterschool and teen programs.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
 17 human services for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 39. There is appropriated out of the general  
 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
 21 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
 22 Revised Statutes, to Hale Mahaolu for personal care services.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 40. There is appropriated out of the general  
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
6 the shelter plus care program.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
8 human services for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 41. There is appropriated out of the general  
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
12 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
13 Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care Association for  
14 adult dental care provided or reimbursed by federally qualified  
15 health centers; provided that the funds shall not be used for  
16 any other purpose. The governor is authorized to utilize  
17 enhanced federal medical assistance percentages funds to offset  
18 the amount appropriated; provided that the total amount shall  
19 not exceed \$ .

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
21 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 42. There is appropriated out of the general  
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
 4 Maui community college, University of Hawaii, for the adult  
 5 dental care program.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
 7 human services for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 43. There is appropriated out of the general  
 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
 11 match the federal medicaid allowance allocated to the State for  
 12 adult vision services.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
 14 human services for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 44. There is appropriated out of the general  
 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
 18 outstationed eligibility worker services provided at federally  
 19 qualified health centers.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department  
 21 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 45. There is appropriated out of the general  
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
 4 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
 5 Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care Association for  
 6 outreach services provided at federally qualified health  
 7 centers.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
 9 human services for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 46. There is appropriated out of the general  
 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
 13 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
 14 Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care Association for  
 15 outreach services to locate uninsured children for services at  
 16 federally qualified health centers.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
 18 human services for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 47. There is appropriated out of the general  
 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
 21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
 22 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii





1 Revised Statutes, to Adult Friends for Youth for youth gang  
2 prevention and intervention services.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
4 human services for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 48. There is appropriated out of the general  
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
8 the office of youth services for a youth gang response system.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
10 human services for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 49. There is appropriated out of the general  
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
14 child care subsidies.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
16 human services for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 50. There is appropriated out of the general  
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
20 the united peer learning integrated new knowledge program for  
21 statewide non-school hour programs.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of  
2 youth services of the department of human services for the  
3 purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 51. There is appropriated out of the general  
5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
7 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
8 Revised Statutes, to Hawaii Centers for Independent Living for  
9 statewide independent living services.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
11 human services for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 52. There is appropriated out of the general  
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
15 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
16 Revised Statutes, to the Partners in Development Foundation to:

- 17 (1) Provide comprehensive family training (early  
18 childhood, parent, adult education, and intensive  
19 child-caregiver activities) and transitional services  
20 to sheltered and unsheltered homeless families on the  
21 leeward coast of Oahu;



1 (2) Offer early screening, assessment, and referral  
2 services for homeless children from birth to age five;  
3 and

4 (3) Prepare homeless children for kindergarten by  
5 providing developmentally appropriate social,  
6 emotional, and cognitive activities in a child-  
7 caregiver interactive learning environment.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
9 human services for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 53. There is appropriated out of the general  
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
13 the homeless programs office of the department of human  
14 services, to assist homeless and at-risk individuals and  
15 families with housing placement, health, education, employment,  
16 and other support services.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
18 human services for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 54. There is appropriated out of the general  
20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for a  
22 rental assistance program, also known as a shallow subsidy



1 program, for sheltered homeless who are ready to rent permanent  
2 housing in order to obtain and maintain permanent housing;  
3 provided that the maximum subsidy shall be \$300 per month after  
4 households pay a minimum of thirty per cent of their adjusted  
5 income for rent.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
7 human services for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 55. There is appropriated out of the general  
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
11 the preschool open doors program.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
13 human services for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 56. There is appropriated out of the general  
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
17 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
18 Revised Statutes, to The Children's Alliance of Hawaii, Inc. to  
19 provide child sexual assault services.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
21 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 57. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
4 education and prevention related to children exposed to domestic  
5 violence and dating violence.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
7 human services for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 58. There is appropriated out of the general  
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
11 auxiliary necessary staffing for domestic violence shelters.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
13 human services for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 59. There is appropriated out of the general  
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
17 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
18 Revised Statutes, to Catholic Charities Hawaii to provide intra-  
19 familial sexual assault services.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for  
21 the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 60. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for  
4 domestic violence services.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for  
6 the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 61. There is appropriated out of the general  
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
10 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
11 Revised Statutes, to Domestic Violence Action Center to provide  
12 specialized legal and advocacy services for victims of domestic  
13 violence.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for  
15 the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 62. There is appropriated out of the general  
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to  
19 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
20 Revised Statutes, to:

21 (1) Volunteer Legal Services Hawaii to provide pro bono  
22 legal services for indigent persons;



1 (2) The Legal Aid Society of Hawaii to provide general  
2 civil legal services; and

3 (3) The Hawaii Family Law Clinic to provide services to  
4 obtain temporary restraining orders;

5 to be distributed as follows:

- 6 (1) Volunteer Legal Services Hawaii \$
- 7 (2) Legal Aid Society of Hawaii \$
- 8 (3) Hawaii Family Law Clinic \$

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for  
10 the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 63. There is appropriated out of the general  
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for
