
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MANAGEMENT OF STATE FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (b) to read:

4 "(b) Not later than January 1, [~~2009~~] 2013, the
5 [~~department of budget and finance,~~] chief information officer,
6 in accordance with this section, shall establish, implement, and
7 maintain a single searchable website, accessible by the public
8 at no cost, that includes for each state award:

- 9 (1) The name of the entity receiving the award;
- 10 (2) The amount of the award;
- 11 (3) Information on the award, including transaction type,
12 funding agency, program source, and an award title
13 descriptive of the purpose of each funding action;
- 14 (4) The full address of the entity receiving the award and
15 the primary location of performance under the award;
- 16 (5) A unique identifier of the entity receiving the award
17 and of the parent entity of the recipient, if the
18 entity is owned by another entity; and



1 (6) Any other relevant information specified by the
2 department of budget and finance.

3 The website shall include data for fiscal year [~~2008~~] 2012
4 and each fiscal year thereafter.

5 The [~~director of finance~~] chief information officer is
6 authorized to designate one or more state agencies to
7 participate in the development, establishment, maintenance, and
8 support of the website; provided that the department of
9 accounting and general services, in collaboration with the
10 department of budget and finance, is responsible for collecting
11 and posting on the website, the information that is required by
12 this subsection. In the initial designation, or in subsequent
13 instructions and guidance, the [~~director~~] chief information
14 officer may specify the scope of the responsibilities of each
15 agency.

16 State agencies shall comply with the instructions and
17 guidance issued by the [~~director of finance~~] chief information
18 officer and shall provide appropriate assistance to the
19 [~~director~~] chief information officer upon request, so as to
20 assist the [~~director~~] chief information officer in ensuring the
21 existence and operation of the website."

22 2. By amending subsections (d) through (h) to read:



1 "(d) Not later than [~~July 1, 2008,~~] January 1, 2014, the
2 [~~director of finance~~] chief information officer shall establish
3 and implement a pilot program to:

- 4 (1) Test the collection and accession of data about
5 subgrants and subcontracts; and
- 6 (2) Determine how to implement a subaward reporting
7 program across the State, including:
 - 8 (A) A reporting system under which the entity issuing
9 a subgrant or subcontract is responsible for
10 fulfilling the subaward reporting requirement;
11 and
 - 12 (B) A mechanism for collecting and incorporating
13 agency and public feedback on the design and
14 utility of the website.

15 The pilot program shall terminate not later than
16 [~~January 1, 2010,~~] July 1, 2015.

17 (e) Based on the pilot program, not later than [~~January 1,~~
18 ~~2010,~~] July 1, 2015, the [~~director of finance,~~] chief
19 information officer:

- 20 (1) Shall ensure that data regarding subawards are
21 disclosed in the same manner as data regarding other
22 state awards; and

- 1 (2) Shall ensure that the method for collecting and
- 2 distributing data about subawards:
- 3 (A) Minimizes burdens imposed on state award
- 4 recipients and subaward recipients;
- 5 (B) Allows state award recipients and subaward
- 6 recipients to allocate reasonable costs for the
- 7 collection and reporting of subaward data as
- 8 indirect costs; and
- 9 (C) Establishes cost-effective requirements for
- 10 collecting subaward data under block grants,
- 11 formula grants, and other types of assistance to
- 12 local governments.

13 For subaward recipients that receive state funds through

14 county governments, the [~~director of finance~~] chief information

15 officer may extend the deadline for ensuring that data regarding

16 such subawards are disclosed in the same manner as data

17 regarding other state awards for a period not to exceed eighteen

18 months, if the [~~director~~] chief information officer determines

19 that compliance would impose an undue burden on the subaward

20 recipient.

21 (f) Any entity that demonstrates to the [~~director of~~

22 ~~finance~~] chief information officer that the gross income, from



1 all sources, for the entity did not exceed \$300,000 in the
2 previous tax year of that entity shall be exempt from the
3 requirement to report subawards under subsection (d), until the
4 [~~director~~] chief information officer determines that the
5 imposition of such reporting requirements will not cause an
6 undue burden on the entity.

7 (g) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the [~~department~~
8 ~~of budget and finance~~] chief information officer from including
9 through the website established under this section access to
10 data that is publicly available in any other state database.

11 (h) The [~~director of finance~~] chief information officer
12 shall submit to the legislature not later than twenty days prior
13 to the convening of each regular session an annual report
14 regarding the website established under this section.

15 Each report shall include:

- 16 (1) Data regarding the usage and public feedback on the
17 utility of the site (including recommendations for
18 improving data quality and collection);
- 19 (2) An assessment of the reporting burden placed on state
20 award and subaward recipients; and
- 21 (3) An explanation of any extension of the subaward
22 reporting deadline, if applicable.



1 The [~~director of finance~~] chief information officer shall
2 make each report publicly available on the website established
3 under this section."

4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
