
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 356D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) If a vacancy occurs for the resident member seat on
4 the board, the resident advisory board shall compile a list of
5 no less than three but no more than five individuals for the
6 governor's consideration for appointment to the board; provided
7 that the nominees to the board shall be:

8 (1) Participants who are directly assisted by the
9 authority under the federal public housing or section
10 8 tenant-based programs and who need not be members of
11 the resident advisory board;

12 (2) At least eighteen years of age; and

13 (3) Authorized members of the assisted household."

14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
