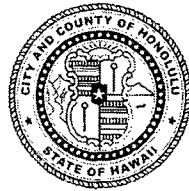

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY**

**PROPOSED REVISED 'EWA DEVELOPMENT PLAN**

As required by Ordinance 00-16, the Department of Planning and Permitting has concluded its comprehensive review of the 'Ewa Development Plan ('Ewa DP). The results of that review are summarized in a two volume Review Report and serve as the basis for proposed revisions to the 'Ewa DP and for suggestions for improving implementation of the Plan's vision and policies.

The Review Report and the proposed revised 'Ewa DP and draft adopting ordinance have been transmitted to the Planning Commission as the first step in the official process of review and action.

The 'Ewa DP is 'Ewa's long-range land use and infrastructure planning document. It is one of eight regional long-range plans required by the Honolulu City Charter and is intended to guide City land use approvals and permits and capital investment projects and to influence private sector investment decisions for 'Ewa.

The Department will make presentations at the 'Ewa Neighborhood Board meeting on October 13 and at the Makakilo/Kapolei/Honokai Hale Neighborhood Board meeting on October 26. In addition, the Department will hold a Public Information Meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 1 at Kapolei Hale.
