

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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DELIVERY OF GOVERNMENT SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103F-203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " ~~[+]§103F-203[-]~~ ~~[Collaboration]~~ Participation of  
4 providers. ~~[Provider participation in a state agency's efforts~~  
5 ~~to plan or purchase health or human services, prior]~~ (a) Prior  
6 to [the] a state agency's release of a request for proposal  
7 under section 103F-402, at the request of the agency, a provider  
8 shall participate in the agency's development of a delivery plan  
9 for health and human services, including [the], as necessary:

10 (1) The sharing of information on community needs, best  
11 practices, and providers' resources[-];

12 (2) Evaluating efficiencies in delivering existing  
13 services and recommending strategies for eliminating  
14 gaps in service delivery; and

15 (3) Recommending cost-efficient and effective service  
16 alternatives.



1        (b) A state agency may include a provision in a contract  
 2 awarded under this chapter a requirement that the provider  
 3 participate in planning pursuant to subsection (a); provided  
 4 that notice of this requirement shall be provided in the request  
 5 for proposals; and provided further that participation in  
 6 planning pursuant to subsection (a) [~~shall be encouraged, and,~~  
 7 ~~as determined by rules,~~] shall not disqualify [~~providers~~] a  
 8 provider from submitting responses to requests for proposals."

9        SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
 11 begun before its effective date.

12        SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14        SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
