

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT
MAXIMIZATION SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 353C-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) Moneys in the federal reimbursement maximization
4 special fund shall be used by the department [~~to meet the state
5 match requirement for federal grants and costs associated with
6 federal grant reporting requirements, including administrative
7 expenses such as the creation and hiring of temporary staff, and
8 for any other purpose deemed necessary by the department for
9 maintaining existing federal grants as well as pursuing federal
10 grants.] for the following purposes:~~

11 (1) To meet the state match requirement for federal grants
12 and costs associated with federal grant reporting
13 requirements, including administrative expenses such
14 as the hiring of temporary staff;

15 (2) For any other purpose deemed necessary by the
16 department for maintaining existing federal grants as
17 well as pursuing federal grants;




- 1 (3) To hire consultants to provide training for
- 2 corrections officers;
- 3 (4) To hire consultants to conduct facility or program
- 4 evaluations;
- 5 (5) To rent or purchase vehicles to transport inmates;
- 6 (6) To provide pre-release and reentry programs;
- 7 (7) To improve technology; and
- 8 (8) To develop a plan for workforce recruitment and
- 9 retention."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
