

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2012.

3 SECTION 2. Act 61, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, is amended by
4 amending part II to read as follows:

5 "PART II PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS

6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be
7 sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of funding
9 specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium beginning July
10 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013. The total expenditures and the
11 number of permanent positions established in each fiscal year of
12 the fiscal biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position
13 ceilings indicated for each year, except as provided in this Act.

3 "PART IV CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

4 SECTION 7. The sum of [~~\$31,424,000~~] \$38,456,000
5 appropriated or authorized in part II of this Act for capital
6 improvement projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the
7 projects listed below; provided that several related or similar
8 projects may be combined into a single project, if a combination
9 is advantageous or convenient for implementation; and provided
10 further that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall
11 not exceed the total of the sums specified for the projects
12 separately. The amount after each cost element and the total
13 funding for each project listed in this part is in thousands of
14 dollars.

1 SECTION 4. Act 61, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011 is amended
2 by amending part V to read as follows:

3 "PART V ISSUANCE OF BONDS

4 SECTION 8. General obligation bonds may be issued, as
5 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to
6 finance projects authorized in part II and listed in part IV of
7 this Act; provided that the sum total of the general obligation
8 bonds so issued shall not exceed [~~\$31,424,000.~~] \$38,456,000".

9 SECTION 5. Act 61, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, is amended
10 by adding a new section to part VI to read as follows:

11 "SECTION 9.1 Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the
12 appropriations under Act 139, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009,
13 section 8, in the amount indicated or balances thereof,
14 unallotted, allotted, unencumbered, or encumbered and
15 unrequired, are hereby lapsed:

19 SECTION 6. If any portion of this Act or its application
20 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any
21 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall
22 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is




1 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
2 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
3 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
4 extent possible.

5 SECTION 7. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
6 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice
7 is authorized to correct the error. All changes made pursuant
8 to this section shall be reported to the legislature at its next
9 regular session.

10 SECTION 8. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
