


Pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, I am returning herewith, without my approval, House Bill No. 2436, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to the Information Privacy and Security Council."

The purpose of this bill is to allow the Chief Information Officer or the officer's designee to serve as the Chair of the Information Privacy and Security Council.

This bill's companion measure, Senate Bill No. 2698, was also passed by the Legislature. Because I approved Senate Bill No. 2698 on April 24, 2012, as Act 71, there is no need to also approve House Bill No. 2436.

For the foregoing reason, I am returning House Bill No. 2436 without my approval.

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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE INFORMATION PRIVACY AND SECURITY COUNCIL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 487N-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) There is established an information privacy and  
4 security council within the department of accounting and general  
5 services for administrative purposes only. Members of the  
6 council shall be appointed no later than September 1, 2008, by  
7 the governor without regard to section 26-34 and shall be  
8 composed of the following representatives:

9 (1) Executive agencies that maintain extensive personal  
10 information in the conduct of their duties, including  
11 the department of education, the department of health,  
12 the department of human resources development, the  
13 department of human services, and the University of  
14 Hawaii, to be selected by the governor;

15 (2) The legislature, to be selected by the president of  
16 the senate and the speaker of the house of  
17 representatives;
