
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIQUOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 281-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) Class 1. Manufacturer license. A license for the
4 manufacture of liquor shall authorize the licensee to
5 [manufacture]:

6 (1) Manufacture the liquor therein specified [~~and to~~
7 ~~sell~~];

8 (2) Sell it [~~at wholesale~~] in original packages to any
9 [~~person~~] wholesaler who holds a license to resell it
10 [~~and to sell~~]; and

11 (3) Sell [~~draught~~] beer, [~~or~~] wine [~~manufactured from~~
12 ~~grapes or other fruits grown in the State~~], or other
13 specified liquor manufactured or distilled in the
14 State in any quantity:

15 (A) At wholesale in original packages to any person
16 who holds a license to resell it; and

17 (B) [~~to~~] To any person for private use and
18 consumption.



1 Under this license, no liquor shall be consumed on the
2 premises, except as authorized by the commission. Of this
3 class, there shall be the following kinds:

- 4 (1) Beer;
- 5 (2) Wine;
- 6 (3) Alcohol; and
- 7 (4) Other specified liquor.

8 It shall be unlawful for any holder of a manufacturer
9 license to have any interest whatsoever in the license or
10 licensed premises of any other licensee. This subsection shall
11 not prevent the holder of a manufacturer license under this
12 chapter or under the law of another jurisdiction from
13 maintaining any interest in the license or licensed premises of
14 a wholesale dealer licensee under this chapter."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 3000.

Allows holders of Class 1 manufacturer liquor licenses to sell beer, wine, or other specified liquor manufactured or distilled in Hawaii in any quantity to wholesalers or for private use and consumption. Effective January 1, 3000. (HB1925 HD1)
