
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide employer
2 contribution amounts for plan years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 for
3 Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund health benefit plan
4 premiums for public officers and employees pursuant to section
5 89-11(g), Hawaii Revised Statutes, due to an impasse in negotiations
6 on issues involving the employer-union health benefits trust fund.

7 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that for the employees of
8 collective bargaining unit (9) and for state officers and employees
9 who are excluded from collective bargaining and who belong to the
10 same compensation plans as those officers and employees within
11 collective bargaining unit (9) for plan years 2011-2012 and
12 2012-2013, subject to the applicable provisions of chapters 87A and
13 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the employer monthly contributions to
14 the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund ("trust fund")
15 are as follows:

16 (1) The amounts paid by the employer in plan years 2011-2012
17 and 2012-2013 for July 1, 2011, through December 31, 2011,
18 and January 1, 2012, through June 30, 2013, for each

3 SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect
4 retroactive to July 1, 2011.
