1	SECTION	V 1.	Section	353-61,	Hawaii	Revised	Statute	s, is

- 3 "§353-61 Hawaii paroling authority; appointment; tenure;
- 4 qualifications. (a) Members of the paroling authority shall be
- 5 nominated by a panel composed of the chief justice of the Hawaii
- 6 supreme court, the director, the president of the bar
- 7 association of Hawaii, a representative designated by the head
- 8 of the Interfaith Alliance Hawaii, a member from the general
- 9 public to be appointed by the governor, and the president of the
- 10 Hawaii chapter of the National Association of Social Workers.
- 11 The panel shall submit to the governor the names of not less
- 12 than three persons, designated as the nominees, for chairperson
- 13 or as a member, for each vacancy. The requirement for
- 14 nomination by the panel established under this section shall
- 15 only apply to a nominee's nomination by the governor to an
- 16 initial term on the paroling authority and not to any subsequent
- 17 consecutive term of a sitting paroling authority member or

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- 1 chairperson whose initial appointment to office was made
- 2 pursuant to a nomination by the panel.
- 3 (b) The governor shall appoint, in [+]the[+] manner
- 4 prescribed by section 26-34, a paroling authority to be known as
- 5 the Hawaii paroling authority, to consist of [three] five
- 6 members, one of whom shall be designated chairperson.
- 7 Appointments shall be made for terms of four years, commencing
- 8 from the date of expiration of the last preceding term. Any
- 9 vacancy in an unexpired term shall be filled by appointment for
- 10 the [+]remainder[+] of the unexpired term. Nominees to the
- 11 authority shall be selected on the basis of their qualifications
- 12 to make decisions that will be compatible with the welfare of
- 13 the community and of individual offenders, including their
- 14 background and ability for appraisal of offenders and the
- 15 circumstances under which offenses were committed."
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 353-63, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 "§353-63 Service of Hawaii paroling authority members;
- 19 compensation; expenses. The chairperson of the Hawaii paroling
- 20 authority shall serve on a full-time basis. The other [two]
- 21 four members shall serve on a part-time basis. Effective
- 22 July 1, 2005, the chairperson of the Hawaii paroling authority



- 1 shall be paid a salary set at eighty-seven per cent of the
- 2 salary of the director of public safety. The compensation of
- 3 each of the part-time members shall be eighty per cent of the
- 4 hourly wage paid the chairperson. For each hour engaged in the
- 5 official duties of the authority, each part-time member of the
- 6 authority shall be paid an hourly wage at the percentage rate
- 7 specified in this section based on the hourly wage paid the
- 8 chairperson; provided that compensation shall not exceed eighty
- 9 per cent of the total regular working hours in a month; provided
- 10 further that part-time members shall not be entitled to any
- 11 vacation, sick leave, or other benefits except as provided in
- 12 this section. All paroling authority members shall receive
- 13 their necessary expenses for travel and incidentals [which] that
- 14 shall be paid from appropriations provided the authority for
- 15 such purposes, on vouchers approved by the director of public
- 16 safety."
- 17 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for
- 20 the Hawaii paroling authority to increase its membership from
- 21 three to five members.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 2 paroling authority for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
