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# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO ENGAGE  
IN EFFORTS TO ACQUIRE THE PARCEL OF KAKAAKO MAKAI LAND  
COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE "HONOLULU FORD PARCEL" AND OTHER  
LANDS OWNED BY KAMEHAMEHA SCHOOLS LOCATED IN KAKAAKO MAKAI.

1 WHEREAS, the John A. Burns School of Medicine produces  
2 high-quality physicians, biomedical scientists, and allied  
3 health workers for Hawaii and the Pacific; and  
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5 WHEREAS, the mission of the University of Hawaii Cancer  
6 Center is to be a world leader in eliminating cancer through  
7 research, education, and improved patient care; and  
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9 WHEREAS, the affiliation between the John A. Burns School  
10 of Medicine and the University of Hawaii Cancer Center has  
11 created a nexus of medical and scientific achievement in Kakaako  
12 makai; and  
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14 WHEREAS, the State's acquisition of land in Kakaako makai  
15 for medical and scientific purposes could contribute to the  
16 synergy between the John A. Burns School of Medicine and the  
17 University of Hawaii Cancer Center; now, therefore,  
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19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
20 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
21 of 2012, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Community  
22 Development Authority is requested to engage in efforts to  
23 acquire the parcel of Kakaako makai land commonly known as the  
24 "Honolulu Ford parcel" and other lands owned by Kamehameha  
25 Schools located in Kakaako makai; and  
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27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, upon acquiring the "Honolulu  
28 Ford parcel" or other lands owned by Kamehameha Schools located  
29 in Kakaako makai, the Hawaii Community Development Authority is  
30 requested to develop or cause the development of the parcels for



1 medical or scientific uses that contribute to the synergy  
2 created in Kakaako makai by the John A. Burns School of Medicine  
3 and the University of Hawaii Cancer Center; and  
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5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Community  
6 Development Authority is requested to submit a report of its  
7 progress in acquiring the "Honolulu Ford parcel" and other lands  
8 owned by Kamehameha Schools located in Kakaako makai, including  
9 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than  
10 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of  
11 2013; and  
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13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the  
15 Chairperson of the Board of the Hawaii Community Development  
16 Authority, the Dean of the John A. Burns School of Medicine, the  
17 Director of the University of Hawaii Cancer Center, and the  
18 Chairperson of the Board of Trustees of Kamehameha Schools.
