
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

CONVENING A MANOA ROAD TASK FORCE TO DISCUSS OWNERSHIP,
MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PORTION OF
MANOA ROAD LEADING UP TO THE LYON ARBORETUM.

1 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii Lyon Arboretum and
2 Botanical Garden is the only university botanical garden located
3 in a tropical rainforest in the United States, as well as the
4 only easily accessible tropical rainforest on the island of
5 Oahu; and
6

7 WHEREAS, the arboretum consists of almost two hundred acres
8 at the top of the Manoa watershed with a set of small cottages
9 and greenhouses used for research and community education about
10 plants and the natural environments of Hawaii; and
11

12 WHEREAS, the arboretum hosts approximately thirty-four
13 thousand visitors each year who participate in classes, research
14 projects, or other community activities or simply explore the
15 grounds to enjoy the beautiful displays; and
16

17 WHEREAS, several community organizations use the arboretum
18 as their base of operations, including Hui Hana, Garden Club of
19 Honolulu, and the Arboretum Association; and
20

21 WHEREAS, Manoa Road is the only road that provides access
22 to the arboretum; and
23

24 WHEREAS, it is unclear which entity owns the portion of
25 Manoa Road leading to the entry to Lyon Arboretum and,
26 therefore, which entity is responsible for road maintenance and
27 repair; and
28

29 WHEREAS, the most efficient and effective way to determine
30 which entity is responsible for that portion of Manoa Road is to



1 convene a task force of stakeholders to reach consensus on the
2 issue; now, therefore,
3

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
5 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
6 of 2012, the Senate concurring, that the Chairperson of the
7 Board of Land and Natural Resources is requested to convene a
8 Manoa Road Task Force to examine and make a recommendation to
9 resolve the ownership, maintenance, and repair responsibility of
10 the portion of Manoa Road leading up to the Lyon Arboretum; and
11

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED it is requested that the following
13 members or their designees serve on the task force:
14

- 15 (1) The Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural
16 Resources, who is requested to serve as chairperson of
17 the task force;
- 18 (2) The President of the University of Hawaii;
- 19 (3) Director of Transportation;
- 20 (4) Director of Transportation Services of the City and
21 County of Honolulu;
- 22 (5) State legislators from the Senate and the House of
23 Representatives who represent the area that includes
24 Lyon Arboretum;
- 25 (6) The Honolulu City Council member who represents the
26 Fifth District of the City Council;
- 27 (7) Chairperson of the Board of Paradise Park, Inc.; and
28 (8) A resident who resides in close proximity to the Lyon
29 Arboretum, to be appointed by the Honolulu City
30 Council member who represents the Fifth District of
31 the City Council; and

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to
34 report its findings and recommendations, including proposed
35 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior
36 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2013; and
