
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CREATE A VEHICLE
REGISTRATION CREDIT FOR RESIDENTS WHO DRIVE LIMITED MILES
IN THEIR VEHICLE.

1 WHEREAS, the cost of vehicle registration has increased
2 significantly in the past year and become a burden to our local
3 families who rarely utilize their vehicles; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu bases the majority
6 of its vehicle registration fees on vehicle weight rather than
7 miles driven; and
8

9 WHEREAS, most of the vehicle registration fees are spent on
10 road repair and maintenance for those who spend significant time
11 on the road; and
12

13 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii currently has more than one
14 million registered motor vehicles with users who have very
15 disparate travel and use needs; and
16

17 WHEREAS, the cost of vehicle registration should be borne
18 primarily by those who use spend the most time on Hawaii roads;
19 and

21 WHEREAS, those residents who drive less make less use of
22 our roads yet currently contribute the same amount in fees; now,
23 therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
26 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
27 of 2012, the Senate concurring, that the City and County of
28 Honolulu is urged to create a vehicle registration credit for
29 residents who drive limited miles in their vehicle; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this credit shall equal a discount of ten percent of the total registration fee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, the members of the Honolulu City Council, and the City and County of Honolulu Motor Vehicles, Licensing and Permitting Division.
