
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO EXTEND THE HOURS
DURING WHICH PARKING IS PROHIBITED ON ISENBERG STREET.

1 WHEREAS, traffic congestion on Oahu continues to be a major
2 concern; and

3
4 WHEREAS, the Bingham Street off-ramp on the H-1 Freeway is
5 a major exit for Moiliili residents, as well as residents of and
6 visitors to the University of Hawaii at Manoa area; and

7
8 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu already recognizes
9 the need to keep two lanes open for rush hour traffic on
10 Isenberg Street between Beretania Street and South King Street
11 by prohibiting parking on the Ewa side of Isenberg Street
12 between the hours of 3:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.; and

13
14 WHEREAS, traffic along Isenberg continues to be heavy after
15 5:30 p.m. as vehicles wishing to turn left onto South King
16 Street prevent vehicles from continuing straight on Isenberg
17 Street due to the parked vehicles blocking the right lane, often
18 backing traffic up across Beretania Street; and

20 WHEREAS, a simple, inexpensive solution to this problem
21 would be to extend the hours when parking is prohibited along
22 Isenberg Street for an additional thirty minutes from 5:30 p.m.
23 to 6:00 p.m.; now, therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
26 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
27 of 2012, that the City and County of Honolulu is requested to
28 extend the hours during which parking is prohibited on Isenberg
29 Street between Young Street and South King Street for an
30 additional thirty minutes from 5:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
33 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of
34 Honolulu, Chairperson of the Honolulu City Council, and the
