A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DELIVERY OF GOVERNMENT SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:
4 "§103F- Health and human services delivery plan;
5 contract provisions; updates. (a) No later than December 31,
6 2012, the director of health and the director of human services,
7 in consultation with health and human services contract
8 providers, shall develop a health and human services delivery
9 plan that evaluates efficiencies in delivering existing services
10 and recommends strategies for eliminating gaps in service
11 delivery and providing cost-efficient, effective service
12 alternatives.
13 (b) The director of health and the director of human
14 services shall review the health and human services delivery
15 plan annually and shall update and revise the plan as necessary.
16 The director of health and the director of human services shall
17 report their findings and recommendations to the legislature no



1 later than twenty days prior to the convening of each regular
2 session after December 31, 2012.

3 (c) Each contract to provide health and human services
4 entered into pursuant to this chapter after December 31, 2012,
5 shall contain a provision that requires the provider to
6 participate in the development or annual review of the health
7 and human services delivery plan."

8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
