A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE PROCUREMENT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Procurements of \$25,000 to less than \$100,000 shall
4 be made in accordance with small purchase procedures [~~;~~ provided
5 that small purchase procurements through an electronic system
6 shall be required after the policy board has adopted rules for
7 electronic procurement and provided training to the affected
8 agency]."

9 SECTION 2. Act 175, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, section
10 14, as amended by section 1 of Act 107, Session Laws of Hawaii
11 2010, is amended to read as follows:

12 "SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009;
13 provided that:

14 (1) [~~Part I~~] Section 1 shall be repealed on July 1, 2012,
15 and [~~sections~~] section 103D-102 [~~and 103D-305~~], Hawaii
16 Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in
17 which [~~they~~] it read on the day before the effective
18 date of this Act; and



1 (2) Sections 7, 9, and 10 of this Act shall be repealed on
 2 July 1, 2011, and sections 103D-709, 103D-710(c), and
 3 103D-710(e), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be
 4 reenacted in the form in which they read on the day
 5 before the effective date of this Act."

6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
 9 provided that section 2 shall take effect on June 30, 2012.

Description:

Makes permanent the amendments made to section 103D-305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, by Act 175, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, that increase the limits on procurements qualifying for certain small purchase procedures to \$100,000 for goods or services and \$250,000 for construction; require procurements greater than \$50,000 for construction to require performance bonds, and require procurements of \$25,000 to less than \$100,000 to be made in accordance with small purchase procedures. Removes the requirement from section 103D-305 that procurements of \$25,000 to less than \$100,000 be done through an electronic system.
