# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE INFORMATION PRIVACY AND SECURITY COUNCIL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 487N-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3           "(a) There is established an information privacy and  
4 security council within the department of accounting and general  
5 services for administrative purposes only. Members of the  
6 council shall be appointed no later than September 1, 2008, by  
7 the governor without regard to section 26-34 and shall be  
8 composed of the following representatives:

9           (1) Executive agencies that maintain extensive personal  
10 information in the conduct of their duties, including  
11 the department of education, the department of health,  
12 the department of human resources development, the  
13 department of human services, and the University of  
14 Hawaii, to be selected by the governor;

15           (2) The legislature, to be selected by the president of  
16 the senate and the speaker of the house of  
17 representatives;



1 (3) The judiciary, to be selected by the administrator of  
2 the courts; and

3 (4) The four counties, to be selected by the mayor of each  
4 county; provided that the mayor of each county shall  
5 determine the extent to which the county may or may  
6 not participate.

7 The [~~comptroller~~] chief information officer or the chief  
8 information officer's designee shall serve as chair of the  
9 council."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
