
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 281, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§281- Server or seller certification. (a) The liquor
5 commission of each county may prohibit any person from working
6 as a server or seller at a licensed premise in the county unless
7 the person is certified by the liquor commission as a server or
8 seller.

9 (b) The liquor commission of each county may adopt rules
10 to develop and offer a certification program, either alone or in
11 conjunction with the liquor commission of any other county, to
12 provide training for persons to work as servers or sellers at
13 licensed premises within the respective county; provided that
14 the county liquor commissions may provide for reciprocity
15 arrangements among the liquor commissions of the several
16 counties.

17 (c) The requirements of subsection (a) shall not apply to
18 employees who are not servers or sellers for whom occasional



1 deliveries of unopened bottles of beer, wine, or liquor are
2 merely incidental to the employee's job duties or to those
3 employees who are not servers or sellers and whose job duties
4 include replenishing the contents of minibars."

5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
