# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A SUNRISE ANALYSIS OF THE PROPOSED LICENSING OF COLON  
HYDROTHERAPISTS AND COLON HYDROTHERAPY ESTABLISHMENTS.

1           WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires a  
2 concurrent resolution requesting a sunrise analysis by the  
3 Auditor of any measure proposing a new regulation of unregulated  
4 profession and occupation; and  
5

6           WHEREAS, S.B. No. 2334, Regular Session of 2012, proposes  
7 to license and regulate the practice of colon hydrotherapy by  
8 requiring licensing of colon hydrotherapists and colon  
9 hydrotherapy establishments; and

11           WHEREAS, colon hydrotherapy is not presently regulated; and  
12

13           WHEREAS, the practice of colon hydrotherapy may have  
14 consequences for the public health and safety; now, therefore,  
15

16           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth  
17 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2012, the  
18 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is  
19 requested to conduct an analysis pursuant to section 26H-6,  
20 Hawaii Revised Statutes, of the proposed licensing of colon  
21 hydrotherapists and colon hydrotherapy establishments under S.B.  
22 No. 2334, 2012; and

24           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to  
25 report findings and recommendations in accordance with section  
26 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Legislature no later than  
27 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of  
28 2013; and
