# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE  
REGULATION AND LICENSURE OF MUSIC THERAPISTS.

1           WHEREAS, S.B. No.           , introduced during the 2012 Regular  
2 Session, proposes the regulation and licensure of music  
3 therapists; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, persons who hold themselves out as music  
6 therapists are not presently required to be licensed, certified,  
7 registered, or otherwise regulated by the State; and  
8

9           WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires  
10 certain regulatory measures to be referred to the Auditor for  
11 analysis if the regulatory measures being considered for  
12 enactment would subject unregulated professions and vocations to  
13 licensing upon enactment; and  
14

15           WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, further  
16 requires that referral to the Auditor shall be by a concurrent  
17 resolution that identifies a specific legislative bill to be  
18 analyzed; now, therefore,

20           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth  
21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2012, the  
22 House of Representatives concurring, that in accordance with  
23 section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Auditor is  
24 respectfully requested to conduct a sunrise review of the  
25 licensure of music therapists; and

27           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is further  
28 requested to submit findings and recommendations, including any  
29 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty  
30 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2013; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this  
2 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor.
