
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2014-2015 to fund the Honolulu zero to three court program for:
- 6 (1) The coordinator's transportation to visit children and
7 parents;
 - 8 (2) Emergency housing assistance;
 - 9 (3) A secure opening at a residential drug and alcohol
10 facility that will accommodate a mother and child;
 - 11 (4) Development and implementation of an incentive program
12 similar to the successful model utilized in family
13 drug court;
 - 14 (5) Training and professional development of zero to three
15 court team members and community partners; and
 - 16 (6) Creation and utilization of an enhanced visitation and
17 parenting coaching site in leeward Oahu.



1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
2 for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
