SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE TO ESTABLISH A WORKING
GROUP TO DISCUSS STRATEGIES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND
EXPANSION OF GEOTHERMAL ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY.

1 WHEREAS, there is growing concern about the rising cost of
2 energy in Hawaii; and

3
4 WHEREAS, Hawaii's natural resources, such as geothermal
5 energy, help reduce the State's dependence on imported oil for
6 its energy needs and make the State more self-sufficient; and

7
8 WHEREAS, geothermal energy in Hawaii has proven to be a
9 reliable, inexhaustible energy source that is nearly emission-
10 free; and

12 WHEREAS, geothermal energy in Hawaii offers tremendous
13 potential for growth and expansion; and

15 WHEREAS, the State needs a sound, comprehensive strategy to
16 ensure that geothermal energy is developed in an economically
17 feasible manner that still protects public health, the
18 environment, and cultural rights; and

20 WHEREAS, a working group is necessary to discuss strategies
21 for the development and expansion of geothermal energy and
22 technology, including geothermal energy and technology
23 development on the island of Hawaii and the development of a
24 geothermal energy and technology park; now, therefore,

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh
27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013, the
28 House of Representatives concurring, that the President of the
29 Senate is requested to establish a Geothermal Energy and
30 Technology Working Group to discuss strategies for the
31 development and expansion of geothermal energy and technology in
32 Hawaii, including but not limited to geothermal energy and



1 technology development on the island of Hawaii and the
2 development of a geothermal energy and technology park; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Geothermal Energy and
5 Technology Working Group be composed of the following members:

- 7 (1) The Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural
8 Resources, or the Chairperson's designee;
- 9
- 10 (2) The Chairperson of the Board of Directors of the High
11 Technology Development Corporation, or the
12 Chairperson's designee;
- 13
- 14 (3) The Mayor of the County of Hawaii, or the Mayor's
15 designee;
- 16
- 17 (4) The Chairperson of the Hawaii County Council, or the
18 Chairperson's designee;
- 19
- 20 (5) A native Hawaiian cultural expert to be selected by
21 the Mayor of the County of Hawaii;
- 22
- 23 (6) A private sector business member to be selected by the
24 Mayor of the County of Hawaii; and

- 26 (7) A community member of the County of Hawaii to be
27 selected by the Mayor of the County of Hawaii; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Senate
30 select a member of the Geothermal Energy and Technology Working
31 Group to serve as its Chairperson; and

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Geothermal Energy and
34 Technology Working Group is requested to submit a report of its
35 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
36 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior
37 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2014 and cease to
38 exist on June 30, 2014; and

40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
41 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the
42 Senate; Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources;
43 Chairperson of the Board of Directors of the High Technology
44 Development Corporation; Mayor of the County of Hawaii;
