SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE OFFICE OF PLANNING TO ESTABLISH A WORKING GROUP TO DETERMINE POTENTIAL PARCELS OF LAND UNDER THE OWNERSHIP OF THE STATE OR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU WHERE JURISDICTION SHOULD BE EXCHANGED TO FACILITATE SPECIFIC MISSIONS.

1 WHEREAS, the State and the City and County of Honolulu own
2 parcels of land that fall under each other's jurisdictions; and
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4 WHEREAS, the jurisdictional transfer of certain parcels of
5 land from the State to the City and County of Honolulu would
6 facilitate the completion of projects undertaken by the County
7 and City of Honolulu; and
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9 WHEREAS, likewise the jurisdictional transfer of certain
10 parcels of land from the City and County of Honolulu to the
11 State would facilitate the completion of state-run projects; and
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13 WHEREAS, the State owns land on and surrounding several
14 rail transit station centers, and the City and County of
15 Honolulu requires access to these state-owned parcels of land
16 for the purposes of pass-through, infrastructure easements, and
17 other necessary activities; and
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19 WHEREAS, the State is currently seeking to redevelop
20 certain schools as part of their Twenty-First Century School
21 Initiative, but potential candidate schools for the initiative
22 are located on county-owned land; now, therefore,
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24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh
25 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013,
26 that the Office of Planning of the Department of Business,
27 Economic Development, and Tourism is urged to establish a
28 working group to determine potential parcels of land under the
29 ownership of the State or the City and County of Honolulu where
30 jurisdiction should be exchanged to facilitate the completion of
31 specific missions; and
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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is encouraged
2 to include two members of the Senate appointed by the Senate
3 President, two members of the House of Representatives appointed
4 by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Chairperson
5 of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, and the
6 Superintendent of Education; and
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8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
9 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Business, Economic
10 Development, and Tourism; Chairperson of the Board of Land and
11 Natural Resources; Superintendent of Education; Director of the
12 Office of Planning; Senate President; and Speaker of the House
13 of Representatives.
