
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ADOPT
RULES TO MANAGE MANTA RAY DIVE SITES.

1 WHEREAS, the manta ray night dive is a popular activity in
2 West Hawaii, and visitors visit Hawaii Island for the purpose of
3 participating in this activity; and

5 WHEREAS, these dives occur at specific locations where
6 manta rays are known to frequent; and

8 WHEREAS, the popularity of this activity has grown over the
9 years and now there are many boats present at these sites at the
10 same time creating a dangerous situation; and

11
12 WHEREAS, if an accident occurred, it would be not only
13 tragic, but harmful to the diving industry, and a potential
14 liability to the State; and

15
16 WHEREAS, ensuring the safety of workers, visitors, and
17 manta rays, and ensuring a good visitor experience is in the
18 best interests of all; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
21 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
22 Session of 2014, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
23 Land and Natural Resources is urged to adopt rules to better
24 manage specific manta ray dive sites to ensure that safety and
25 order is maintained; and
