# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT TO RETURN LANDS IN LUALUALEI VALLEY CURRENTLY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE UNITED STATES NAVY TO THE STATE OF HAWAII.

1           WHEREAS, in 1930 and 1933, approximately 1,700 acres in  
2 Lualualei Valley were taken from the Hawaiian Home Lands under  
3 federal executive orders from the Territory of Hawaii and turned  
4 over to the United States Navy for ammunition storage; and  
5

6           WHEREAS, Lualualei Valley is the largest coastal valley on  
7 the leeward side of Oahu, and is composed mainly of agricultural  
8 land; and  
9

10          WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii wants to increase its food  
11 sustainability and security needs, as well as develop additional  
12 agricultural infrastructure, tasks requiring land areas such as  
13 those contained in Lualualei Valley; and  
14

15          WHEREAS, the return of land in Lualualei Valley from the  
16 United States Navy to the State of Hawaii would go a long way to  
17 helping Hawaii meet its food sustainability and security needs;  
18 now, therefore,  
19

20          BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
21 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
22 Session of 2014, the Senate concurring, that the United States  
23 Government is urged to return lands in Lualualei Valley  
24 currently under the jurisdiction of the United States Navy to  
25 the State of Hawaii; and

27          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the  
29 United States, United States Secretary of Defense, United States  
30 Secretary of the Navy, Hawaii's Congressional delegation,
