# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS PERMIT FEES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the display permit  
2 fee, which authorizes licensed pyrotechnicians to conduct  
3 outdoor aerial fireworks and indoor fireworks for theatrical  
4 purposes, has remained the same for thirteen years, but the cost  
5 to process, review, and approve permits has increased. The  
6 purpose of this Act is to raise the fireworks display permit fee  
7 from \$110 to \$300.

8           SECTION 2. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
9 amended to read as follows:

10           "**§132D-10 Permits.** A permit shall be required for the  
11 purchase and use of:

12           (1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers  
13           upon payment of a fee of \$25;

14           (2) Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles  
15           pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon  
16           payment of a fee of [~~\$110~~] \$300; and

17           (3) Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section  
18           132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time

1           other than during the periods prescribed in section  
2           132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of \$25."

3           SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
