
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 for the executive office on early learning to enter into
3 contracts with third party providers for family-child
4 interaction learning programs as part of a mixed-delivery early
5 learning system to ensure school readiness for Hawaii's children
6 prior to entering kindergarten.

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the
10 executive office on early learning to enter into contracts with
11 third party providers for family-child interaction learning
12 programs.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive
14 office on early learning for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
