
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ANIMAL QUARANTINE SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 142-28.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 repealed.

3 ~~["§142-28.5 Animal quarantine special fund. There is~~
4 ~~established the animal quarantine special fund to be~~
5 ~~administered by the board of agriculture. Moneys received by~~

7 ~~(1) Fees for the quarantine of cats, dogs, and other~~

6 SECTION 2. The director of finance shall transfer all
7 unexpended and unencumbered balances remaining as of July 1,
8 2014, in the animal quarantine special fund established by
9 section 142-28.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the credit of the
10 general fund. Additionally, any revenues scheduled to be paid
11 into the animal quarantine special fund after July 1, 2014,
12 shall be paid to the credit of the general fund.

13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 to cover
16 all costs of animal quarantine including, but not limited to,
17 the costs of salaries, fringe benefits, operating expenses,
18 defrayed quarantine fees, equipment, motor vehicles, contracts
19 with any qualified person or entities for animal care services,
20 operation and maintenance of the quarantine station, and
21 promotional expenses.























1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
