A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the growing prison
 population has raised serious concerns regarding the collateral
 effects of incarceration on the children and families of
- 4 incarcerated persons and the communities from which they came.
- 5 According to the federal Bureau of Justice Statistics' most
- ${f 6}$ recent study on incarcerated parents in the United States, more
- 7 than 1,700,000 minors, representing 2.3 per cent of the
- 8 population, have at least one incarcerated parent.
- 9 The legislature further finds that the incarceration of a
- 10 parent is a traumatic event for children. Studies show that a
- 11 substantial number of incarcerated parents were deeply involved
- 12 in their children's lives before imprisonment by providing daily
- 13 care, as well as financial and emotional support. Studies also
- 14 show that the incarceration of a parent is likely to result in
- 15 unstable family relationships, poor academic performance,
- 16 financial instability, material hardship, and social stigma.
- 17 Providing social services and programs for children who
- 18 have a parent in the prison system supports the children's SB2308 SD1 LRB 14-1159.doc



- 1 emotional and behavioral well-being. Furthermore, providing
- 2 support to incarcerated parents and their children preserves and
- 3 strengthens family connections, which yield positive societal
- 4 benefits in the form of reduced recidivism, less
- 5 intergenerational criminal justice system involvement, and
- 6 improved healthy child development.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funding for
- 8 programs and services for children of incarcerated parents and
- 9 to assist with family reunification.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
- 13 funding programs and services for children of incarcerated
- 14 parents and assisting with family reunification.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
