
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LATEX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§321- Dental health facilities; health care facilities;
5 use of latex gloves prohibited. The use of latex gloves in
6 dental health facilities and health care facilities, including
7 all facilities listed in section 321-11(10), shall be
8 prohibited."

9 SECTION 2. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by adding a new section to part XVIII to be
11 appropriately designated and to read as follows:

12 "§321- Emergency medical services; use of latex gloves
13 prohibited. The use of latex gloves by personnel providing
14 ambulance services or emergency medical services pursuant to
15 this part shall be prohibited."

16 SECTION 3. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
18 designated and to read as follows:



1 "§328- Food establishments; use of latex gloves
 2 prohibited. The use of latex gloves in a food establishment
 3 permitted under title 11, chapter 12 of the Hawaii
 4 administrative rules shall be prohibited."

5 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
