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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KING KAMEHAMEHA CELEBRATION COMMISSION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 8-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended as follows:

3           1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

4           "(a) There shall be a commission to be known as the King.  
5 Kamehameha celebration commission placed within the department  
6 of accounting and general services for administrative purposes.  
7 The commission shall consist of thirteen members to be appointed  
8 by the governor in the manner provided by section 26-34. The  
9 appointments shall be made from the following organizations,  
10 with at least one member from each organization:

- 11           (1) Royal Order of Kamehameha I;  
12           (2) 'Ahahui Ka'ahumanu;  
13           (3) Hale O Nā Ali'i O Hawai'i 'Ahahui Po'o;  
14           (4) Daughters and Sons of Hawaiian Warriors;  
15           (5) Kamehameha Schools Alumni Association;  
16           (6) Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs;



- 1 (7) Waimanalo [~~Homesteaders~~] Hawaiian Homestead
- 2 Association;
- 3 (8) Kapahulu Music Club; [~~and~~]
- 4 (9) Papakolea Community Association [~~-~~]; and
- 5 (10) Daughters of Hawai'i.

6 In addition, the governor shall appoint one member from  
 7 each of the following [~~islands-~~] counties: Kaua'i, Maui,  
 8 [~~Molokai,~~] and Hawai'i. Each of these members shall be a  
 9 resident of the respective [~~island~~] county that the member  
 10 represents."

11 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:

12 "(d) The commission may appoint and dismiss an arts  
 13 program specialist and a part-time clerk typist, without regard  
 14 to chapter 76, who shall serve at the commission's pleasure, and  
 15 whose salaries shall be provided through [~~fees, public~~  
 16 ~~contributions, and private donations-~~] state funds."

17 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
 19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the  
 20 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year



1 2016-2017 for the operating cost of the King Kamehameha  
2 celebration commission.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
4 of accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
