# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 302A-1143, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "§302A-1143 Attending school in what service area. A  
4 person of school age shall be required to attend the school of  
5 the service area, as determined by the department, in which the  
6 person resides, unless:

7           (1) The person is enrolled in a Hawaiian language medium  
8 education program or charter school;

9           (2) A geographic exception to attend a school in another  
10 service area is requested and granted at the  
11 discretion of the department; [~~or~~]

12           (3) Out-of-service-area attendance is mandated by the  
13 department or by federal law[~~-~~]; or

14           (4) The person attends a public charter school and has  
15 been notified of the prospect of charter revocation or  
16 nonrenewal in accordance with section 302D-18 or of  
17 closure in accordance with section 302D-19."



1           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
