# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GLASS ADVANCE DISPOSAL FEE PROGRAM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) There is established in the department of  
2 health, for administrative purposes only, a glass advance  
3 disposal fee working group to review and discuss the findings  
4 and recommendations contained in the December 2014 audit report  
5 of the department of health's glass advance disposal fee program  
6 (Report No. 14-16). The working group shall include the  
7 following members or their designees:

- 8           (1) The state auditor;  
9           (2) The director of health;  
10          (3) The state solid waste management coordinator; and  
11          (4) One representative with county glass collection  
12             program experience from each of the four counties, to  
13             be selected by the mayor of each respective county.

14          (b) The working group shall examine and evaluate the glass  
15 advance disposal fee program by:

- 16          (1) Determining the feasibility of a glass advance  
17             disposal fee increase;



- 1           (2) Determining whether the purpose of the glass advance  
2           disposal fee is to fully fund or merely supplement  
3           county glass collection programs;
- 4           (3) Determining whether the glass advance disposal fee  
5           achieves the department of health's collection and  
6           recycling goals for non-deposit glass;
- 7           (4) Developing solutions to address any glass advance  
8           disposal fee problem areas; and
- 9           (5) Considering any other issues the working group deems  
10          appropriate, based on the findings and recommendations  
11          contained in the December 2014 audit report of the  
12          department of health's glass advance disposal fee  
13          program (Report No. 14-16).
- 14          (c) The working group shall submit a written report of its  
15          findings and recommendations, including any proposed  
16          legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior  
17          to the convening of the regular session of 2016.
- 18          (d) The members of the working group shall serve without  
19          compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including  
20          travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties.

1 (e) The working group shall cease to exist on June 30,  
2 2016.

3 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
