# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 286-41(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes,  
2 requires that every owner of a motor vehicle which is to be  
3 operated upon the public highways shall apply to the director of  
4 finance of the county where the vehicle is to be operated, for  
5 the registration thereof. Section 286-42, Hawaii Revised  
6 Statutes, allows the county director of finance to enter into a  
7 contract with new car dealerships and motor vehicle rental  
8 companies for the registration of new motor vehicles.

9           The legislature finds that the registration of used cars or  
10 previously owned vehicles is the responsibility of the  
11 individual buyer, whereas the registration of new cars is  
12 commonly undertaken by the dealership. The legislature further  
13 finds that used car dealerships and rental car companies are  
14 increasing their sales of used cars in response to growing  
15 consumer demand. The legislature further finds that car dealers  
16 and rental car companies should be able to register used cars  
17 when the cars are sold to the same extent as new car dealers and  
18 motor vehicle rental companies.



1           The purpose of this Act is to allow the respective county  
2 directors of finance to enter into contracts with car  
3 dealerships and motor vehicle rental companies to register used  
4 cars.

5           SECTION 2. Section 286-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
6 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

7           "(a) Every owner of a motor vehicle which is to be  
8 operated upon the public highways shall, for each vehicle owned,  
9 except as herein otherwise provided[7] and except as provided in  
10 section 286-42(c), apply to the director of finance of the  
11 county where the vehicle is to be operated, for the registration  
12 thereof. If a vehicle is moved to another county and is to be  
13 operated upon the public highways of that county, the existing  
14 certificate of registration shall be valid until its expiration  
15 date, at which time the owner shall apply to the director of  
16 finance of the county in which the vehicle is then located for  
17 the registration of the vehicle, whether or not the owner is  
18 domiciled in the county or the owner's principal place of  
19 business is in that county, except that this provision shall not  
20 apply to vehicles which are temporarily transferred to another  
21 county for a period of not more than three months."



1 SECTION 3. Section 286-42, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) The director of finance may enter into a contract  
4 with [~~new~~] car dealerships and motor vehicle rental companies  
5 for the registration of new and used motor vehicles consistent  
6 with any statute, ordinance, or provision of any applicable  
7 collective bargaining agreement. The director of finance may  
8 adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 as may be necessary for the  
9 application, bonding, and procedural requirements of [~~such~~] the  
10 contractor."

11 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
