
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to address the
2 issues surrounding historic residences by directing the state
3 historic preservation division to temporarily redirect its
4 resources to conduct a survey of potential historic districts
5 and single-family residences for eligibility for listing on the
6 Hawaii register of historic places.

7 SECTION 2. (a) The state historic preservation division
8 of the department of land and natural resources shall conduct a
9 survey to identify potential historic districts and single-
10 family residences that may be eligible for listing on the Hawaii
11 register of historic places.

12 (b) The state historic preservation division of the
13 department of land and natural resources shall submit a report
14 to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
15 convening of the regular session of 2018. The report shall
16 include the results of the division's compliance with subsection
17 (a), including the number and types of properties examined and



1 identified as potentially eligible to be included on the Hawaii
2 register of historic places.

3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
6 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
7 2016-2017 to be deposited into the Hawaii historic preservation
8 special fund.

9 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii
10 historic preservation special fund the sum of \$ or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
12 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2016-2017 to conduct a survey to identify potential
14 historic districts and single-family residences that may be
15 eligible for listing on the Hawaii register of historic places.

16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
17 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
