# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO CONSOLIDATE ITS LEILEHUA-MILILANI-WAIALUA COMPLEX AREA ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE AND SUPPORT SERVICES FACILITIES AND USE THESE EXISTING LOCATIONS TO GENERATE INCOME FOR CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, RETROFITTING, AND MAINTENANCE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES.

1           WHEREAS, facilities maintenance and sustainability are two  
2 major funding issues facing public schools; and

3  
4           WHEREAS, the infrastructure of the twenty-first century  
5 school must be energy efficient and provide access to the latest  
6 technology to prepare students to succeed in a highly  
7 competitive economy; and

8  
9           WHEREAS, the Department of Education's Central Oahu  
10 District consists of the Aiea-Moanalua-Radford and Leilehua-  
11 Mililani-Waialua Complex Areas; and

12  
13           WHEREAS, the Leilehua-Mililani-Waialua Complex Area  
14 administrative office is located in Mapunapuna and its support  
15 services are spread across the Leilehua-Mililani-Waialua Complex  
16 Area; and

17  
18           WHEREAS, these facilities and lands have the potential to  
19 be utilized to generate revenue; and

20  
21           WHEREAS, the State owns property identified as tax map key  
22 number 7-4-004:070 on California Avenue in Wahiawa, where the  
23 Wahiawa Public Library is currently located; and

24  
25           WHEREAS, the consolidation of all services related to the  
26 Leilehua-Mililani-Waialua Complex Area to the property  
27 identified by tax map key number 7-4-004:070 will create a  
28 central location that provides improved access to services and  
29 programming offered through a single Leilehua-Mililani-Waialua  
30 Complex Area Office; now, therefore,

 2 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth  
 3 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2015, the  
 4 House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Education  
 5 is requested to consolidate the Leilehua-Mililani-Waialua  
 6 Complex Area administrative office and support services  
 7 facilities into a single facility in Wahiawa at the property  
 8 identified by tax map key number 7-4-004:070; and  
 9

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this facility house the  
 11 consolidated Leilehua-Mililani-Waialua Complex Area  
 12 administrative office and support services facilities as well as  
 13 the Wahiawa Public Library, currently located on the property,  
 14 and the Storefront Program; and  
 15

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education is  
 17 requested to consider Act 155, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, and  
 18 other channels to facilitate the construction of the new  
 19 facility; and  
 20

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education is  
 22 requested to seek opportunities to generate revenue from the  
 23 land that was previously used by the Leilehua-Mililani-Waialua  
 24 Complex Area administrative office and support services  
 25 facilities, and to deposit such revenue into the school  
 26 facilities subaccount for the purposes of construction, repair,  
 27 retrofitting, and maintenance of school facilities; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
 30 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the  
 31 Board of Education and Superintendent of Education.
