SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE OLDER AMERICANS ACT
AND DESIGNATING MAY AS "OLDER AMERICANS MONTH" IN HAWAII.

1 WHEREAS, the Older Americans Act passed Congress in 1965;

4 WHEREAS, the Older Americans Act has been instrumental in
5 delivering nutrition and social services to older persons across
6 the country; and

8 WHEREAS, the Older Americans Act has provided for community
9 service employment for low-income older Americans; training,
10 research, and demonstration activities in the field of aging;
11 and support for vulnerable elder rights protection; and

13 WHEREAS, the Older Americans Act has provided targeted
14 programs and services for Native Hawaiian elders; now,
15 therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth
18 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2015, the
19 House of Representatives concurring, that the month of May of
20 each year be designated "Older Americans Month" in Hawaii in
21 recognition of the fiftieth anniversary of the Older Americans
22 Act and of all the contributions made by older Americans in the
23 State of Hawaii; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
26 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and the
27 Director of Health.
