Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 749  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish the Beach Clean-  
Up Special Fund, which shall be funded by:

- (1) The imposition of a Beach Clean-Up Cigarette Fee on the  
wholesalers and dealers of cigarettes;
- (2) Appropriations made by the legislature; and
- (3) Donations and contributions made by private individuals  
or organizations.


A concerned individual provided testimony in support of this  
measure. The Department of Budget and Finance commented on this  
measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your  
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 749  
and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be placed on the  
calendar for Third Reading.
