A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO JURY DUTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 612-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as
3 follows:

4 "§612-8 Pay of jurors; mileage fee; bus fare; parking
5 violations exemption. (a) Each juror or prospective juror
6 shall be paid \$30 for each day of actual attendance at court.
7 In addition, each juror or prospective juror shall be paid the
8 higher of either:

9 (1) 33 cents for each mile actually and necessarily
10 traveled in going to and from court[-]; or

11 (2) The cost of an adult bus fare to and from the court.

12 A person who appears at the time for which that person is
13 summoned to court for jury duty may be allowed the mileage fee
14 or bus fare although the person, upon that person's request, is
15 subsequently excused or exempted from jury service."

16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

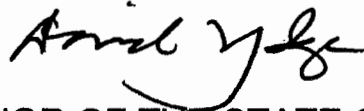
