## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO POLICE DEPARTMENTS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that requiring county
- 2 police departments to post their domestic violence policies,
- 3 officer-involved domestic violence policies, and standards of
- 4 conduct online will offer assurances to the public that there
- 5 are policies in place for responding to these incidents.
- 6 Posting these policies online will bring additional
- 7 accountability and transparency to the police departments and
- 8 ensure that police departments properly enforce the State's
- 9 domestic violence laws, regardless of the identity of the
- 10 perpetrator.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to require each county police
- 12 department to post its policies relating to domestic violence,
- 13 officer-involved domestic violence, and standards of conduct on
- 14 its official website.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 52D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 17 and to read as follows:

1	"§52D- Domestic violence policies; standard of conduct
2	policies. Each county police department shall post its policies
3	relating to domestic violence, officer-involved domestic
4	violence, and standards of conduct on its official website."
5	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
