A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

PART I

1 SECTION 1. (a) The state historic preservation division
2 of the department of land and natural resources shall conduct a
3 survey to identify potential historic districts and single-
4 family residences that may be eligible for listing on the Hawaii
5 register of historic places.

7 (b) The state historic preservation division of the
8 department of land and natural resources shall submit a report
9 to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
10 convening of the regular session of 2018. The report shall
11 include the results of the division's compliance with subsection
12 (a), including the number and types of properties examined and
13 identified as potentially eligible to be included on the Hawaii
14 register of historic places.

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
18 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year



1 2016-2017 to be deposited into the Hawaii historic preservation
2 special fund.

3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii
4 historic preservation special fund the sum of \$100,000 or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
7 year 2016-2017 to conduct a survey to identify potential
8 historic districts and single-family residences that may be
9 eligible for listing on the Hawaii register of historic places.

10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
11 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

12 **PART II**

13 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000 or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
17 2016-2017 for deposit into the Hawaii historic preservation
18 special fund.

19 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii
20 historic preservation special fund the sum of \$150,000 or so
21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and



1 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
2 year 2016-2017 to implement a data management plan for the
3 digitization of historic preservation records.


4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
5 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this part.

6 **PART III**

7 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
