# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE ACQUISITION OR DEVELOPMENT OF REAL PROPERTY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a significant  
2 proportion of the State's public employee work force is  
3 concentrated in downtown Honolulu. As many state agencies and  
4 employees are outgrowing existing office space and aging  
5 infrastructure, there is a pressing need for the State to  
6 identify and acquire or build additional office space in urban  
7 Honolulu to accommodate state governmental agencies and offices.

8           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to  
9 identify, plan, and acquire or build upon real property in urban  
10 Honolulu to provide office space for state governmental agencies  
11 and offices.

12          SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so  
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 to  
15 identify, plan, and acquire or build upon real property in urban  
16 Honolulu to provide office space for state governmental agencies  
17 and offices.
