
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 15-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) Immediately upon receipt of a request for absentee
4 ballot within the time limit specified in section 15-4, the
5 clerk shall examine the records to ascertain whether [~~or not~~]
6 the voter is lawfully entitled to vote as requested. [~~As seen~~
7 ~~as the printed official ballots are available,~~] If the clerk
8 ascertains that the voter is lawfully entitled to vote as
9 requested, no earlier than thirty days before the election, the
10 clerk shall mail in a forwarding envelope, or deliver in person
11 if the voter appears at the office of the clerk, an official
12 ballot and other materials prescribed in section 15-6, except
13 that an incapacitated voter may send a representative to obtain
14 the voter's ballots pursuant to the rules [~~promulgated~~] adopted
15 by the chief election officer[~~. All requests received upon the~~
16 ~~last day specified in section 15-4 for receipt shall be mailed~~
17 ~~to the voter requesting the same as soon as reasonably~~



1 ~~practicable, but in no event later than twenty four hours after~~
2 ~~receipt thereof.]; provided that official ballots and other~~
3 ~~materials prescribed in section 15-6 shall be mailed or~~
4 ~~delivered:~~

5 (1) To uniform military and overseas voters pursuant to
6 section 15D-9; and

7 (2) No later than twenty-four hours after receipt of the
8 request for absentee ballot for requests received on
9 the last day specified in section 15-4."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
