A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FUNDRAISERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to prohibit
2 legislators from fundraising during regular sessions of the
3 legislature.

4 SECTION 2. Section 11-342, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended to read as follows:

6 "~~[+]§11-342 [] Fundraiser, notice of intent.]~~ Fundraisers.

7 (a) No fundraiser for which the price or suggested contribution
8 for attending the function is more than \$25 per person shall be
9 held unless a notice of intent to hold the fundraiser is filed
10 with the commission setting forth the name and address of the
11 person in charge, the price per person, the date, hour, and
12 place of the fundraiser, and the method thereof.

13 (b) ~~[The]~~ For fundraisers subject to subsection (a), the
14 person in charge of the fundraiser shall file the notice with
15 the commission prior to the fundraiser.

1 (c) No fundraiser shall be held during the regular session
 2 of the legislature by any candidate for public office who also
 3 holds a seat in the state legislature.

4 [~~e~~] (d) As used in this section, "fundraiser" means any
 5 function held for the benefit of a candidate, candidate
 6 committee, or noncandidate committee that is intended or
 7 designed, directly or indirectly, to raise contributions [~~for~~
 8 ~~which the price or suggested contribution for attending the~~
 9 ~~function is more than \$25 per person]."~~

10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
