# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTIONS COMMISSION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 11-7.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "~~+~~§11-7.5~~+~~ Duties of the elections commission. The  
4 duties of the elections commission are to:

5           (1) Hold public hearings;

6           (2) Investigate and hold hearings for receiving evidence  
7 of any violations and complaints;

8           (3) Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91;

9           (4) Employ, without regard to chapter 76, a full-time  
10 chief election officer, pursuant to section 11-1.6;

12           (5) Conduct a performance evaluation of the chief election  
13 officer after each election and submit a written

14 report of the evaluation to the legislature within

15 ninety days of the certification of election results;
