
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTIONS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-7.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~{}~~§11-7.5~~{}~~ **Duties of the elections commission.** The
4 duties of the elections commission are to:

5 (1) Hold public hearings;

6 (2) Investigate and hold hearings for receiving evidence
7 of any violations and complaints;

8 (3) Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91;

9 (4) Employ, without regard to chapter 76, a full-time
10 chief election officer, pursuant to section 11-1.6;

12 (5) Conduct a performance evaluation of the chief election
13 officer after each general election and submit a
14 written report of the evaluation to the legislature
15 within ninety days of the certification of the general
16 election results; and

17 ~~{}~~ (6) Advise the chief election officer on matters

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.
