Your Committee has reviewed the personal history and resume submitted by the nominee and finds Dr. Reza Danesh to possess the requisite qualifications to be nominated to the Emergency Medical Services Advisory Committee.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination of Dr. Reza Danesh from the Department of Health.

Dr. Danesh is currently a Physician at the Emergency Department at Maui Memorial Medical Center. He earned a Doctor of Medicine from the University of California at Davis School of Medicine and a Bachelor of Science in Biology from the University of California at Los Angeles. He has also served as a physician at various other medical centers, including the California Hospital Medical Center Emergency Department, which is the busiest penetrating trauma center in California.
