The purpose of this measure is to determine the best
practices for collecting, storing, and sharing data on homeless
youth by requesting the Hawaii Interagency Council on Homelessness
to convene a task force that will identify data points most useful
for identifying and assessing the homeless youth population in the
State and design a system for collecting, consolidating, securing,
and sharing that data across departments.
